Vineyard: This vineyard is a bilateral california sprawl.

Soil: The soil is composed mostly of sand and dense clay.

Composition: 95% Pinot Gris and 5% Chenin Blanc

ton bins. We gently macerated the grapes in the bin and allowed an hour of skin contact to enhance varietal flavor. The grapes were then whole cluster pressed to preserve

fruit expression.

Aging: Mixture of stainless tank and stainless barrels.

Tasting Notes: This Pinot Gris immediately intrigues with scents of orange

blossom and stonefruit. As the wine opens, additional floral notes are intertwined in a lemon-lime aroma. The wine has a gripping medium full palate that is balanced by hints of

honey and cream.
